CRITERIA FOR COMPANIES TO OBTAIN CHURCH STATUS IN THE NEW JERSEY CONFERENCE

(Revised 02/06/2020)

A. <u>A minimum of 60 members are required to assure stability and growth.</u>

B. <u>Companies need to meet minimum leadership requirements as directed by the Church</u> <u>Manual.</u>

C. Financial Base:

- 1. The number of giving units must be at least 30.
- 2. Annual tithe of at least \$50,000.00.
- 3. Giving to local church budget should be sufficient to support all local operating and outreach needs.
- 4. Develop adequate plans to meet the educational needs of their young people.
- 5. Have an established building fund.
- D. <u>Evangelism</u>- Companies must have conducted at least two evangelistic series before they make application for church status. Ideally, one of these campaigns should be led by a pastor and the other led by a lay member.
- E. As part of the application for Church status, the company should include their evangelistic plans for the first year of their status as a Church.
- F. <u>Meeting facility</u> The need for adequate meeting facilities to serve a growing church is important to the growth and stability of all Companies and Churches. **Before making application for Church status**, the Company should have a 12-month lease/rental agreement and/or approval to purchase a facility.
- G. Companies desiring to obtain Church status will exhibit a supportive attitude toward the Conference Departments, its ministry and its mission.

H. <u>The application for Church status must be approved by the New Jersey Conference</u> <u>Executive Committee.</u>
