Utrecht: the World Council of Churches
"in process of formation"

1948

Amsterdam: "Men's Disorder and God's Design"
establishment of World Council of Churches

1952

Lund: (Faith and Order)—the church, ways of
worship, intercommunion

1954

Evanston: "Jesus Christ the Hope of the World"

1961

New Delhi: "Jesus Christ, the Light of the
World"—merger of I.M.C. and W.C.C.

1963

Montreal (Faith and Order): "The process of
growing together"

1966

Geneva (Life and Work): "Christians in the
Technical and Social Revolutions of Our Time"

1968

Uppsala: "Behold, I Make All Things New"

Apostolicae Curae (Anglican orders
declared invalid)

1915

Christian Unity Octave—prayers
for "return" of separated Christians

1928

Mortalium Animos (warning against
involvement in pan-Christian activities)

1935

Abbé Couturier suggests new form
for Unity octave prayers

1938

Una Sancta Brotherhood for
ecumenical conversation

1945

Unitas, ecumenical center
established in Rome

1948

(no observers at Amsterdam)

1949

Instruction of the Holy Office,
increasing ecumenical possibilities

1952

observers at Lund

1954

(no observers at Evanston)

1959

Pope John announces Vatican
Council II

1961

observers at New Delhi

1962

Vatican Council II opens
(non-Catholic observers present)

1963

observers at Montreal

1964

Vatican Council II decree
